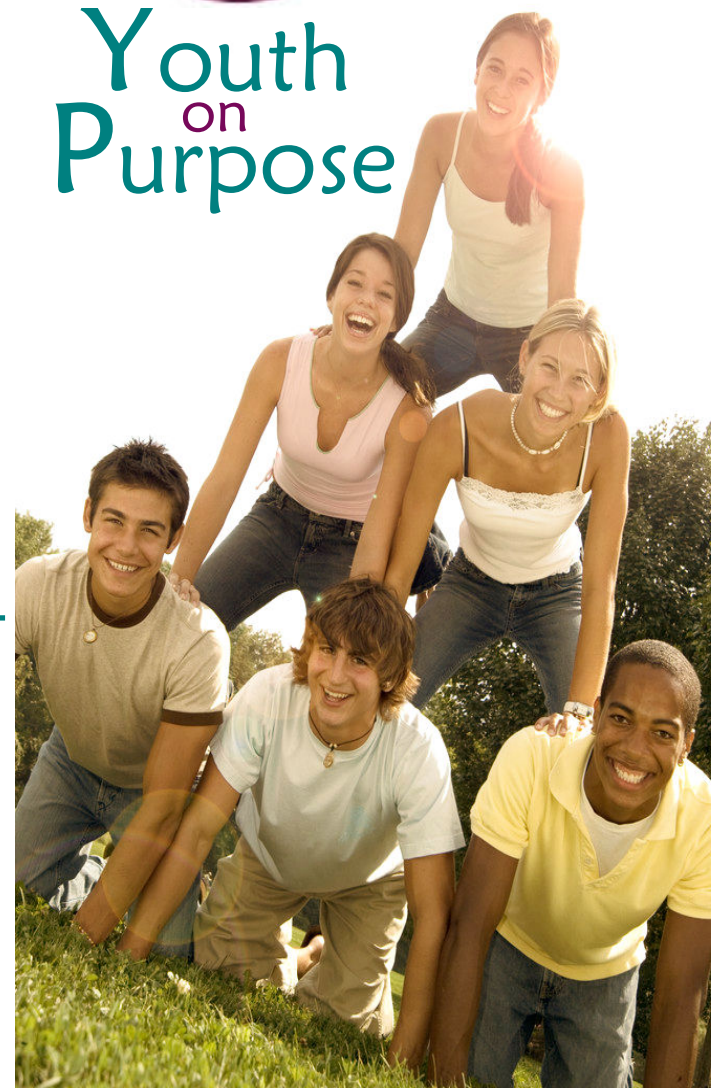

Summer Camp

Several days (length varies by program) of residence in a natural setting with a high facilitator-to-youth ratio. Youth experience intensive courses led by experienced counselors, coaches, and past participants in processes guided by the youth's own personal stories and goals.

Collaborative teaching and learning are emphasized as youth create their own highly individualized course plan.

- ❖ Exercises in empowerment, leadership, trust, and teamwork
- ❖ Outdoor activities including sports, swimming, and hiking
- ❖ Creative projects with art, movement, drama, and music
- ❖ Skills training in goal-oriented career development and personal marketing

Year Long Follow-Up

- ❖ Weekly private and family sessions
- ❖ Weekly group support groups
- ❖ 13 weekend follow-up courses including *The Art of Joining the Family*, *The Art of Surrender*, and *True Woman's/Man's Power*
- ❖ Unlimited phone support
- ❖ One 5 day completion course
